

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF HYTHE  
AND DIBDEN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION HELD AT THE COMMUNITY CENTRE,  
BRINTON LANE, HYTHE ON JANUARY 17th, 1989 1990.

Present: R. Knieriem (chairman) E. Bateman (treasurer) R. White  
(secretary) C Versey, S Wade.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING: The minutes were read and accepted  
as an accurate record of the December 1989 meeting.

MATTERS ARISING: A roof contractor had made a site meeting with the  
secretary and had submitted an estimate for £800 to  
cover repairs and renovations to five sections of the building  
which were subject to leaks. Resolved in the light of the  
satisfactory work on room D2 to accept the tender and give  
the go-ahead for work to proceed.

OPEN DAY: The secretary reported that the open day instigated by  
Sylvia Barton and the walkers group had proved to be a  
major public relations success. An estimated 300 to 350  
people had visited the centre during the open day. Thanks  
were extended to everyone who had taken part, especially Sylvia  
and her helpers. The open day was followed by a thank-you  
party for volunteers and helpers.  
It was noted that on May 12th the horticultural society was  
hiring the centre for a plant sale. It was suggested this  
might be the opportunity for a further open day. Groups will  
be invited to take part.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING: Resolved to hold the 1990 annual meeting at  
the centre at 8pm on Tuesday March 6th. Notices to be posted  
around the centre and sent to group representatives at least  
21 days in advance. Nominations for election of chairman,  
vice-chairman, treasurer and secretary to close at 4pm  
February 27th - seven days before the annual meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mrs. Bateman said the books were ready and ready  
to be submitted to the auditor. She hoped the audited accounts  
would be available at the next meeting. This would mean audited  
accounts would be presented to the annual meeting.

FUND RAISING: The secretary reported that he had received no information  
about the Webb Ivory sales which had been instigated by  
Mrs. Parkes several months previously in aid of the centre's  
building fund. Concern was expressed by the committee at  
the box of Webb Ivory Christmas cards etc still in the centre  
office.

Maintenance: Resolved to release £50 withheld from contractor  
for painting the outside of the building now that it  
was accepted that time had proved the work to be of  
high standard.
