

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE
COMMITTEE OF HYTHE AND DIBDEN COMMUNITY
ASSOCIATION HELD AT THE COMMUNITY CENTRE,
ON APRIL 10th, 1990

PRESENT: R. KNIERIEM (CHAIRMAN) S. WADE (VICE-CHAIRMAN)

1. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING WERE ACCEPTED AS AN ACCURATE RECORD
2. MATTERS ARISING: THE CHAIRMAN REPORTED THAT THE WORK ON THE ROOF HAD BEEN COMPLETED BY CONTRACTORS
3. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: MR KNIERIEM REPORTED THAT THE GLASS IN THE FRONT DOOR HAD TWICE BEEN SMASHED BY HIGH WINDS, BUT THE FIRE BRIGADE HAD RULED THAT THE DOORS COULD NOT BE SWUNG INWARDS TO AVOID FURTHER DAMAGE AS IT WOULD BE A SAFETY HAZARD. THERE HAD BEEN A GOOD TURN-OUT FOR THE SPRING CLEAN WEEKEND WHICH RESULTED IN EXTENSIVE RE-DECORATION AND CLEANING. HE THANKED ALL THOSE INVOLVED
4. SECRETARY'S REPORT: MR WHITE SAID HE WAS PLANNING TO HOLD ANOTHER SESSION ON MAY 19 AND 20 TO TACKLE FURTHER JOBS, INCLUDING THE FENCING ~~AT~~ AT THE REAR OF THE BUILDING WHICH WAS ALSO VICTIM OF THE GALES.
IT WAS ALSO PLANNED TO RENEW THE LIGHTS IN WILSON HALL. MR WHITE AND MR WADE WOULD CHECK PRICES FOR SFT FITTINGS
5. TREASURER'S REPORT: MRS BATEMAN SAID THE ASSOCIATION'S NO 1 BOND WAS NOW WORTH £7,497 WITH INTEREST AND SHE WAS LOOKING INTO MOVING THE MAJORITY OF THE ASSOCIATION'S RESERVES INTO INVESTMENT FUNDS WITH RATES OF 14.7 PERCENT.
6. HIRE CHARGES: RESOLVED TO RAISE HIRE CHARGES FOR COMMUNITY CENTRE ROOMS AND HALLS BY 8 PER CENT FROM MAY 1st, 1990 IN LINE WITH INFLATION. KITCHEN PRICES WOULD ALSO BE REVIEWED.
7. HIRE CONDITIONS: RESOLVED TO CONTINUE POLICY OF NOT ALLOWING TEENAGE OR WEDDING PARTIES TO BE HELD AT THE CENTRE. SATURDAY BOOKINGS WOULD BE ACCEPTED ONLY IF A WARDEN WAS AVAILABLE.
