

MINUTES of A MEETING of HYTHE AND DIBDEN
COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION HELD AT THE COMMUNITY
CENTRE ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1990.

Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as a true record.

Chairman's report: The chairman reported that a roof leak had developed in Room A. It had been repaired and he was waiting for rain to test it.

Secretary's Report: New lighting in Wilson Hall had met with approval from users. A cleanup morning was planned for September 23rd.

Treasurer's report: Mrs Bateman said she had received repayment on the Deposit Bonds totalling £13,957.55. This had been reinvested in the Hampshire Building Society at a specially high rate of interest. She had since invested a further £1,000 bringing a present total of £35,563.17p. investments. The association's current account had been changed to an enterprise account.

Playschool had resumed and payment system now seemed satisfactory.

Playgroup toilet facilities: Playgroup representatives to be invited to next meeting to discuss toilet facilities and plans to carry out work at no expense to the association.

Crafts exhibition and sale: Secretary to investigate informal approach from Southern Crafts, for use of centre

Silver wedding at centre: Resolved to discourage future events due to unsatisfactory behaviour and problems vacating building.

Polling facilities: Agreed to allow centre to be used as polling station next May.

Tuesday warden: Secretary to investigate possibility of getting replacement warden for Tuesdays.
