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MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE OF HYTHE AND DIBDEN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION HELD AT THE COMMUNITY CENTRE, BRINTON LANE, HYTHE ON APRIL 17, 1990.

Present: R. Knieriem, chairman; S. Wade, (vice-chairman; E bateman, treasurer; R. White, secretary; and ten mebers of the association.

Apologies for Absence: None.

Minutes of the annual meeting were approved. There were no matters arising.

The chairman reported that the leaking roof sections had been repaired and the bill had been paid. It was necessary to wait and see how effective the repairs would prove. The standard of the roofing felt used when the building was put up was not really suitable for a long life-span.

Working parties had made an exceptional effort to brighten up the centre on April 7th and 8th. Ceilings damaged by roof leaks had been painted, walls cleaned and painted, windows and blinds cleaned and the entire entrance and passageway had been given a coat of bright paint. A second clean-up campaign was planned for May 19 and 20. Mr. Knieriem thanked those who had taken part.

The treasurer explained details of the association's investments and said that we were currently obtaining 14.7 percent with the Building Society Charities account which was free of tax because of our charity status.

Kitchen prices and hire charges were being raised from May 1. This was the first rise in kitchen charges for four years and only the second rise since the opening of the centre. Room and hall rise charges would as usual rise by the level of current inflation.

Following a request from members, minutes of previous meetings will in future be available before the day of the meeting. When possible they would be sent out with notices.

H. Hunter, K. Webb and C. Versey were elected to the executive committee without a vote. There were no other nominations.

The executive committee agreed to look into the possibility of providing mail pigeon holes for groups in the entrance/office area. Following a discussion about providing staging for use by groups, the executive agreed to review the matter.
