MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING : Accepted and true and accurate
record.

MATTERS ARISING: The playgroup had not received cash grant
from the parish council for alterations to toilet
facilities which had been promised to previous
organisers. They would now be applying for cash to
be released. The new organisers had made welcome
improvements and now had a waiting list of children.
In view of the improvement in the situation it was
agreed to redecorate the hall now that the roof
leaks had been repaired.

Chairman's report; A further £190 had been spent on Ewart Hall
roof leaks. The latest problems had resulted in the
lighting being affected and new units and spare
parts were required. Agreed to reinstate lighting.

Secretary's report: A parent had complained after an incident
at the junior disco in November. It appeared a
sweet was thrown which hit a girl in the eye. The
secretary was satisfied that volunteers had taken
all possible steps to help the girl and prevent
further incidents. Volunteers to be told that
all accidental incidents should be fully reported at
the time.
Agreed to review sweet prices to bring them in line with
average prices at other outlets in the area.
Agreed to purchase three to four dozen tumbler
glasses to replace breakages and losses.

Treasurer's report. The treasurer considered it time to
review investment accounts and recommended the
transfer of assets to a higher bonus account.
Agreed to transfer £45,016.59 from existing
accounts to Bradford and Bingley bonus account.

Any Other Business: A suitable date for a clean-up weekend
at the centre was deferred until the January meeting.
