

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF HYTHE
AND DIBDEN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION HELD AT THE COMMUNITY
CENTRE, BRINTON LANE, ON SEPTEMBER 8, 1992

RENT: The treasurer reported that the parish had informed
her that the rent for the building would be increased in
April 1993. It was resolved to increase the rent for the
New Forest District council offices at the community
centre to £1,100 from the same date.

DISCOS: The secretary said a bill for £24 had been
received from the parish council for the alleged damage
to the clock in the parish hall during the July junior
disco.

It was resolved to increase the disco ticket price to
£1.20 from November. Crisp prices would be raised to 19p

REPAIRS: The secretary reported that a quote of £2,550
had been accepted for the repair of 17 sections of the
roof.

The security alarm and the fire alarm problems had been
sorted out after a period of unreliability.

COMMUNITY BUSES: The committee discussed a suggestion
from the Waterside Council for Community Service to take
over the local community bus project. It was decided to
defer a decision until a visit by organiser Sheila Page.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mrs Bateman reported that she had
transferred a further £1,000 to the deposit account,
making a deposit total of £54,324.
