

Minutes of the General Meeting held at  
the Community Centre on July 4th 1995.

Present: Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and 12 members.

Apologies: Mrs Arbery (Hytha Wives).

Minutes of Last Meeting Signed as a true record.

Matters Arising: None.

Financial Statement: The rent rises which came into force in June were explained and the £5 warden fee for Sat/Sunday sessions. Also raised was the issue of non-standard hours and the fees to be charged. This would be considered by the Executive.

No new investments in the Bradford, Bingley Building Society account could be made as there was a requirement for all signatories to present themselves with identification before changes could be made. The legality of this requirement would be challenged.

5. Wardens: At present there was no warden on Monday evening and Thursday evenings groups were to seek volunteers.

6. New Building The Chairman had talked to the Architect and it is expected that he would approach the planners with concept plans. If agreed, full planning permission would be sought in the next cycle (Probably Sept).

When final plans & permission granted we then

proceed to seek funds from the charities.

Questions were raised about the delay and any legal and financial aspects concerning the Architect.

The Building Committee would meet on July 12th.

Dean & Dyball had expressed an interest in tendering for the new building.

A.O.B, Hythe Arts Festival. The Community Centre would host

Art, Photography, Lace Making & Quilting. Volunteers were sought to operate the kitchen during opening hours.

2. Hall floor - The brown tiles created a problem and needed to be replaced.

3. Cleanliness of the toilets was raised - No complaint had been received by the Centre staff.

4. Window in Gwest Hall was sticking.

5. External painting was on a 3 year cycle and was now due. The wisdom of spending money on this was questioned & we would wait until the result of the planning application was known.
